All nominations are reviewed by the Selection Committee, which consists of one member each from the Flood Insurance Producers National Committee, the WYO Marketing Committee, and the Flood Insurance Committee of the Institute for Business and Horne Safety. After their review, they select the three insurance agencies that most deserve the Agency of the Year Award.

The winning agencies will be announced at the 2003 National Flood Conference Awards Luncheon on Thursday, May 29. The NFIP will provide lodging and will waive conference registration fees for one representative from each of the winning agencies.
