SUBJECT: Activation of the Single Adjuster Program – Virginia

Hurricane Isabel has caused wind and flood damage to residential and commercial properties throughout Virginia. The Federal Emergency Management Agency in conjunction with the Virginia Property Insurance Association (VPIA) has activated the Single Adjuster Program in Virginia.

The Claims Coordinating Office has co-located with NCIUA, and losses sustained in Virginia resulting from Hurricane Isabel will be handled from the existing location in Carey, North Carolina. The VPIA will assign all wind and flood claims to pre-approved adjusters, and the CCO will enter all claims data into the CCO system and fax and/or overnight the losses to the appropriate WYO companies.
