SUBJECT: Closure of the Claims Coordinating Office (CCO) – Hurricane Ivan

During the period of September 15-20, 2004, Hurricane Ivan caused extensive wind and flood damage in Alabama. As a result of this event, the NFIP Bureau and Statistical Agent established a CCO in Foley, Alabama.

The CCO and the Alabama Insurance Underwriting Association have matched and single-adjusted 1,869 losses during this event, and the submission of new claims has diminished. Therefore, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has authorized the CCO to close, effective May 6, 2005.
