SUBJECT: Closure of the Claims Coordinating Office (CCO)—Hurricane Ophelia

During the period of September 11-17, 2005, Hurricane Ophelia caused extensive wind and flood damage in North Carolina. As a result of this event, the NFIP Bureau and Statistical Agent established a CCO in Carey, North Carolina.

The CCO and the North Carolina Insurance Underwriting Association have matched and single-adjusted 365 losses during this event, and the submission of new claims has diminished. Therefore, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has authorized the CCO to close, effective November 25, 2005.
