SUBJECT: Adjusted Dates of Loss – FICOs 296–299 Hurricane Isaac
FL, AL, MS, LA

Hurricane Isaac produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in the states of Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, and Louisiana. In NFIP Clearinghouse Bulletins W-12057 and W-12060, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers 296–299, respectively, to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has since adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event as shown below:
