SUBJECT: Adjusted Dates of Loss – FICO 675–676 & 348–350
2016 Late Winter Severe Storms – AR, LA, MS, TN, TX

The 2016 Late Winter Severe Storms produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in the states of Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee, and Texas. In NFIP Clearinghouse Bulletin W-16012, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers 675–676 & 348–350, respectively, to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event as shown below:
