Hurricane Irma produced torrential rain, storm surge, and widespread flood damage in the states and the U.S. territories listed below. As a result, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has assigned the following FICO numbers 684, 362, 363, 364, 365, and 366, respectively, to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event as shown below:
