Like hurricanes, atmospheric rivers are ranked on a scale from 1 to 5. If your community is expecting an atmospheric river that's on the strong to exceptional end of the scale: shelter right away; evacuate if told to do so; move to higher ground or a higher floor, if possible; and stay indoors until the storm has passed.
